All employees have a legal right to a workplace free from sexual harassment, and The Village of Montgomery is committed to maintaining a workplace free from sexual harassment.

Per New York State Law, The Village of Montgomery has a sexual harassment prevention policy in place that protects you. This policy applies to all employees, paid or unpaid interns and non-employees in our workplace, regardless of immigration status.
