Clinton Street water line

Work will commence on the West End of Clinton Street's new 8" water line the week of June 19th.

This project may take up to two months, but it will probably be completed before that time frame. Businesses on this section of Clinton Street, such as Copperfields, Clinton Shops, Wildfire Grill and The Table should expect some disruption in parking availability and street traffic. The Village DPW and the contractor (SITA Construction) will do whatever possible to streamline the process. Access to part of the street may be possible during certain days like last year on the other part of Clinton Street.

Water/sewer bill

Water/sewer bill payments are due on July 14th without penalty. Postmarked payments are accepted.

Village taxes are due on June 30th without penalty.

10 ways to conserve water

- 1. Dispose of chemicals properly.
- 2. Take used motor oil to a recycling center.
- 3. Limit amounts of fertilizer.
- 4. Take short showers.
- 5. Shut water off while brushing teeth.
- 6. Run full loads of dishes and laundry.

- 8. Water outside only when necessary.
- 9. Keep a pitcher of drinking water in the refrigerator.
- 10. Be involved in water education.
